Bids will be accepted until Monday, March 12, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. at Mason County Judge/Executive's office, 221 Court Street, Maysville, Kentucky. Specifications for the project are:

- I. Storage on hard drive(s)-
 - 6 terabyte hard drives,
 - Booking area- 9 months capture
 - All other areas- 90 days

- II. Number/type of Cameras
 - 22- 360 degree cameras
 - 55 dome cameras for a (total of 77 cameras)
 - All cameras should be equip with night vision
 - 4 megapixel on all and
 - Outdoor cameras- weather resistant.

- III. Ceiling Mounted Audio for booking area

- IV. Training/Technical support for a minimum of three months after installation.

The Mason County Detention Center will be responsible for installation of the Cat 5E data cable for the new camera system and de-installation the old camera system. MCDC will mount cameras with supervision from awarded company. The Company will be responsible to program, test, set-up and configure system.
