



During the month of November the Maysville-Mason County Landfill received a total of 7171.46 tons of waste valued at \$148,693.62 (not including DP&L operational costs). Kentucky Environmental Remediation Fees were \$9,666.84. The FGD fill received a total of 16,461.95 tons valued at \$66,178.15. Roll-off business had a total of \$30,781.41 in billable accounts. 427,000 gallons of leachate was hauled from the Maysville-Mason County Landfill to the city pump station.

**Contained Landfill**

Normal landfilling activity is ongoing. Quarterly ground water and surface water reports were submitted. Tank heaters were installed in the contained landfill tank farm for winterization. NetDMR monthly verifications submitted. Replaced the pneumatic pump in Phase 3. Replaced the pneumatic pump in the knock out tank at the EKP building.

**Residual Landfill**

Site maintenance was performed. Quarterly ground water and surface water reports were submitted. NetDMR monthly verifications submitted. Replaced the pump in Phase 2 collection box.

Judge/Executive Pfeffer called the meeting to order.

#### MINUTES

Judge/Executive Pfeffer presented the Minutes from the October 19, 2015 meeting. The Minutes were presented for informational purposes only.

#### APPROVAL OF SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

Landfill Supervisor Todd Leonard recommended the surplus of three pieces of equipment. A listing of the equipment is made a part of these Minutes. Todd presented a history of the equipment, as well as approximate current market values. It was the recommendation of the Committee to surplus the equipment. The equipment will be presented before the December 15, 2015 meeting of the Mason County Fiscal Court for approval and to determine whether to conduct a public auction or advertise for sealed bids.

#### UPDATE ON INDUSTRIAL SEWER LINE EXTENSION

Judge/Executive Pfeffer reported the project is progressing and Tetra Tech is awaiting to finalize contract work. Information has been submitted to Rural Development..

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.




Older mobile home with unmowed yard but no rubbish. Home in close proximity to other homes. Complaint not filed by neighbors. No violation found.

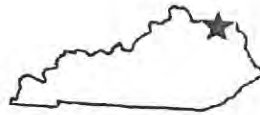


